Federal Home Loan Bank of Indianapolis


WHEREAS, the Affordable Housing Program ("AHP") regulations at 12 C.F.R. § 960.5(b)(7) authorize each Federal Home Loan Bank ("FHLBank or Bank") to establish an AHP priority recommended by the Bank's Advisory Council, adopted by the Bank's board of directors, and approved by the Federal Housing Finance Board ("Board"); and

WHEREAS, the FHLBank of Indianapolis has submitted a request for approval of the 1992 Bank AHP priority recommended by its Advisory Council and adopted by its board of directors; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the proposed priority in accordance with Housing Finance Directorate Procedure Memo 91-1, and both the Community Interest Director and the Board staff recommended approval of the FHLBank of Indianapolis 1992 AHP priority;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED, that the Federal Housing Finance Board, pursuant to its authority to administer the AHP under the Federal Home Loan Bank Act of 1932 (12 U.S.C. § 1430 et seq.), hereby approves the FHLBank of Indianapolis 1992 AHP priority for "Projects that meet documented critical housing needs as a part of a planned community revitalization strategy, leveraging AHP funds with other funds, such as Community Investment Program resources."
